An exciting heliski day on the Grand Combin massif. The 4.300m Swiss giant oversees the Aosta Valley and is visible from the town of Aosta. While the Grand Combin is located in Switzerland, the slopes on the Italian side of the massif provide descents with vertical drops from 700 to 1300 vm. Our ski area is delimited by the Mont Gelé and Glacier, the canyons of the Testa di By and the gentle slopes of the Col de Champillon. The starting point of this exciting experience is the village of Glacier in the municipality of Ollomont. Ollomont is definitely an exclusive heliski area dedicated to off-piste lovers, but above all, in the spring, it is fantastic to ski on the velvety snow.

Flight prices increase in a smaller group). The vertical drops depending on the landing place lie between 700vm and 1300vm.

Ski pass if necessary, rental equipment not included, lunch, drinks, and all other services are not included.

Itinerary:

The meeting point is usually at 8:30 a.m. in Glacier, a little village in the municipality of Ollomont. After the meet & greet, the guide will check and/or provide the safety equipment (avalanche transceiver, shovel, probe and ABS backpack) and give you a safety briefing about the rules and procedures to follow during the day. You will experience the most exciting runs of the area, constantly looking for the best snow. The day ends with a return flight, necessary to reach the valley where you can taste the typical dishes of the valley accompanied by a good bottle of local wine.
